

Javascript 10 - Fetching JSON

Modifying JSON data

1. Remove the call to remove 'd-none' on line **25** of the JavaScript. How does this affect the behavior? **What happens** if you remove the d-none class from the template on line 11 of the HTML?
2. The click event listener does not rely on a `querySelector` to get the DOM element to remove. Why is this not necessary?
3. Change the click event listener to use the following code. How does this change the behavior and why?
`(ev) => ev.target.remove();`

Loading JSON from fetch

4. What is the response variable on line 13? (Change the arrow function to include `console.log(response);`.)
5. What is the text variable on line 15? (Change the arrow function to include `console.log(text);`.)

Loading JSON from fetch

6. Add the following line just after the `data.forEach` (line **11**) and just after the `fetch` (line **13**). Why are the results different?
`console.log(list.childNodes);`
7. What happens if you remove the `link.click()` on line 25? What is this line doing?
8. After loading the fetch data, click on an item or two to remove them, then export the data. Does the downloaded `data.json` file match what you expect?
